Back in July, we had our first ever Whole Church Celebration evening. It was a fantastic time of hearing powerful stories about lives being changed from people across our church family.

Everyone said we should do this again - so we are!

Join us on Tuesday 28<sup>th</sup> January at 7.45pm, as we look back and give thanks for all that God has done in 2024 and look forward to what God is calling us to next. It is going to be an amazing evening!

## Financial Update

We are so thankful to God for the amazing response as people have returned their Commitment Cards for 2025, following our teaching series on Generosity.

For 2025, we had – in faith - budgeted for an increase in giving of £19,590. This gave us a deficit budget of £85,000. From the commitment cards that have been returned so far, the church family have pledged to increase their giving by £32,265 in 2025. We rejoice and give thanks to God for this. It is a fantastic response and answer to prayer – thank you for your generosity!

With this, and some one-off gifts that have been given, we are able to reduce the predicted deficit budget to  $\pounds72,000$ . Praise the Lord!

With such a large deficit, we still need to manage the budget carefully and responsibly. Therefore, if you are a regular giver to HBC, but did not return a commitment card for 2025, we would still love you to do this – we don't want to assume that people are keeping their giving the same, when circumstances may have changed. Thank you so much!

**THANK YOU!** Over 30 hampers were packed and delivered to our clients in time for Christmas thanks to your generosity in donating goods, giving time to pack, and to deliver them.....so THANK YOU!

January is already fully booked with new clients, so Sam and I are going to have a busy start to the year! Pray for us as we continue to get used to the new systems and processes, they are starting to feel a bit more familiar, but work is needed before the system is rolled out nationally.
